**EL PASO, Texas**—The City of El Paso’s Capital Improvement Department is hosting two open house community meetings for the Sun City Lights projects.

Sun City Lights is a program that focuses on creating vibrant destinations and interactive places. The program seeks to transform public spaces into engaging, illuminated experiences that encourage community interaction, enhance existing neighborhoods, and activate economic development.

The projects will be located at Pueblo Viejo Park, 9133 Valdiviez St., in the Misson Valley, and Marty Robbins Park, 11620 Vista Del Sol Dr., on the Eastside.
