Spray parks will be open daily from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., providing fun, free and family-friendly options to beat the heat all summer long.

The Pavo Real Enhanced Spray Park also features a dog spray park, open daily from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., providing a refreshing play area for four-legged family members.
