The El Paso Public Libraries, in partnership with <u>Nuestra Palabra</u> and <u>El Librotraficante</u>, will host a book release and author discussion for the new Simon & Schuster publication, <u>Detained: A Boy's Journal of Survival & Resilience</u>.

The book chronicles the true story of a 13-year-old boy's harrowing journey from his native Honduras to the United States in search of his parents. Upon arriving at the U.S.-Mexico border, he was detained and held at a facility in Tornillo, Texas, where he kept a daily journal of his experiences. Detained offers a powerful first-hand account of his survival, resilience, and hope.

Author and professor Tony Diaz, also known as El Librotraficante, will serve as Master of Ceremonies. The event will feature co-author Ivan Gerardo Morales along with local authors and educators. This stop is part of a statewide book tour that includes Houston, Austin, San Antonio, and El Paso.

The event is free and open to the public. The book will also be available for sale at the event.
