El Paso Fire Department Invites Community to 9/11 Memorial Ceremony Honoring Fallen Heroes

The El Paso Fire Department will host a public memorial ceremony on Thursday, September 11, 2025, to honor the nearly 3,000 lives lost in the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks — including the 343 firefighters who gave their lives in the line of duty.

Joined by local dignitaries, fellow first responders, and community members, firefighters will gather at 8:30 a.m. at Fire Station 18, 7901 San Jose Rd., for a solemn tribute to the courage, sacrifice, and service displayed on that tragic day.

The ceremony will provide an opportunity for El Paso residents to pause and reflect on the bravery of first responders who rushed toward danger to save others, as well as to stand in solidarity with those who continue to serve and protect.

The public is encouraged to attend and take part in remembering the heroes of 9/11.
