# City of El Paso Seeking Applicants for Mobility Advisory Committee

Group Will Help Guide Implementation of Complete Streets Policy

**EL PASO, Texas**—The City of El Paso is inviting residents to apply to serve on the Mobility Advisory Committee (MAC), a community-driven group that will support the implementation and oversight of the City's Complete Streets Policy.

Applications are open now and will be accepted through October 29, 2025.

The Complete Streets Policy is designed to create a connected, resilient, and equitable transportation network that serves all people, whether they walk, bike, use a wheelchair, take public transit, or drive. The City is committed to making streets and roadways safe, accessible, and inclusive for everyone.

The committee aims to ensure transparency and public input in the development of multimodal transportation initiatives. The committee will include 18 community members representing a range of backgrounds and perspectives who will work alongside City staff on roadway and mobility projects.

- **Membership:** Two members will be selected from each City Representative District, plus two at-large members.
- **Commitment:** Members will meet at least quarterly.
- **Term Length:** Two years, ending October 31, 2027.

Note: The committee is not a City Council board or commission and is not governed by Title 2.04 of the El Paso City Code.
