El Paso Public Libraries Drive Literacy Forward With New Bookmobiles

The City of El Paso Public Libraries will unveil two new state-of-the-art Bookmobiles at 11 a.m. Thursday, October 16, at the Memorial Park Branch Library, 3200 Copper Avenue.

These mobile library units will bring essential resources and services directly to neighborhoods without convenient access to a branch.

Designed with modern features and full accessibility, the Bookmobiles make it easier for all residents to check out materials, request items, sign up for library cards, and connect to mobile WiFi.

Each Bookmobile, custom-built by Farber Specialty Vehicles on a Ford 148-inch wheelbase platform at an approximate cost of \$252,802, is equipped with:

- Adjustable/removable bookshelves and book carts
- LED lighting package
- PA system with microphones and exterior speakers
- Air conditioning and generators
- Satellite connectivity
- Wheelchair lift for accessibility (ADA compliant)

After the unveiling, the Bookmobiles will tour select library branches so the public can explore the new vehicles and learn about the mobile services.
