Community Invited to Attend Open House Meetings for Pebble Hills Street Improvement Project

EL PASO, Texas—The City of El Paso's Capital Improvement Department invites the community to attend a series of open house community meetings to learn more about the upcoming Pebble Hills Street Reconstruction and Resurfacing Project.

The meetings will give residents an opportunity to review project details, ask questions, and learn about anticipated construction timelines and traffic impacts.

The approximately \$12.3 million project includes street reconstruction, resurfacing, new street signage and pavement markings, installation of bike lanes, ADA-compliant ramps and sidewalks, and reinforced concrete bus pads along the following segments of Pebble Hills:

Reconstruction: Zaragoza Rd. to Rich Beem Blvd.

Resurfacing: N. Yarbrough Dr. to Lee Trevino Dr.
Outriggers St. to Loop 375
Rich Beem Blvd. to John Hayes St.

This investment underscores the City of El Paso's ongoing commitment to improving roadway conditions, safety, and mobility for all users as part of a comprehensive regional transportation system.
