Community Invited to “Taste of WinterFest” Preview Holiday Treats from the Food Truck Village

EL PASO, Texas—The City of El Paso invites the community to the second annual Taste of WinterFest from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Tuesday, November 18, along Mills Avenue between Mesa and Oregon, next to San Jacinto Plaza.

The lunchtime event offers downtown employees, and visitors the opportunity to sample festive foods and treats that will be featured at this year’s Holiday Food Truck Village during WinterFest.

The Holiday Food Truck Village will officially open to the public on Saturday, November 22, with extended hours for opening day. Beginning Sunday, November 23, the village will be open daily from 5 p.m. to 11 p.m. through January 4, 2026, along Mills Avenue between Mesa and Oregon.

WinterFest itself will officially kick off on Saturday, November 22, featuring the return of the City’s signature holiday lights, ice-skating rink, and festive attractions in and around San Jacinto Plaza.

“WinterFest has become one of El Paso’s most beloved traditions, and our food trucks play a huge part in creating that warm, joyful atmosphere,” said Parks and Recreation Department Director Pablo Caballero. “We invite everyone to come downtown, get a taste of what’s to come, and celebrate the spirit of community that makes WinterFest special.”

A total of five food trucks will serve a mix of traditional holiday snacks and savory dishes, including *fresas con crema*, *conchas rellenas*, *papas* with chicken or *carne asada*, *churros*, and hot chocolate, as well as tacos, quesadillas, and other local favorites.

This year’s participating food trucks include:

The food trucks were selected by a committee based on menu quality, pricing, and presentation to ensure a diverse and festive dining experience for all WinterFest visitors.
