## City Recognizes National Quit Smoking Day

## Encourages Residents to Go Smoke-Free

**El Paso**, **Texas**—The City of El Paso Department of Public Health (DPH), in partnership with the Texas Healthy Communities (TXHC) program and the Paso del Norte Tobacco Control Network is raising awareness about the dangers of tobacco and nicotine use during National Quit Smoking Day, November 20.

This national observance encourages smokers to take the first step towards a healthier, tobacco-free life.

The "Make the Change El Paso" initiative supports the City's Smoke-Free Ordinance, which protects residents and visitors from exposure to secondhand smoke in enclosed public places and workplaces. Through education and outreach, this campaign aims to encourage smoke-free living, support tobacco prevention among youth, and help individuals quit smoking.

According to the CDC, cigarette smoking remains the leading cause of preventable death and disability in the United States. Among Texas high school youth, 18.8% reported currently using a tobacco product, including e-cigarettes, according to 2021 data.
