El Paso International Airport Tips for Holiday Travel, Parking Options

EL PASO, Texas—The City of El Paso's International Airport (ELP) is expanding parking options to better serve the thousands of people traveling this holiday season.

More than 84,000 passengers are expected to fly through El Paso during the Thanksgiving holiday travel period which runs from Friday, Nov. 21, to Monday, Dec. 1.

"We understand the strain that construction can place on travelers, especially during the holidays," said Director of Aviation Tony Nevarez. "These temporary solutions and responsive adjustments reflect our commitment to meeting the community's needs while continuing to improve the airport experience for the future."

Holiday Travel Tips

Travelers are encouraged to:

- Plan ahead and review all parking options at FlyElPaso.com
- Allow extra time to find parking and ride the shuttle
- Be aware of closure dates and signage posted at parking locations
- Check the parking lot status map on the airport website to view real-time availability before arriving.

New Seasonal Lot Now Open

A new and temporary seasonal parking lot is now open at Boeing Drive and Bonanza Street offering 440 additional daily parking spaces to help accommodate increased holiday traffic. The seasonal lot will close after January 2026, and no vehicles may remain in the lot beyond this date.

The Seasonal lot features:

- Daily long-term rate: \$7.00 per day
- Mobile payment only
- Lighting for safety
- Free shuttle service to and from the terminal

Expanded West Lot Now Open

The airport has added temporary millings to its West Lot near the terminal, creating 165 additional daily parking spaces. The expanded area is now open as pay-by-mobile only and increases the total number of spots in the West Lot to 317 spaces.

The entire West Lot will close on January 10, 2026, for reconstruction and landscaping upgrades. No vehicles may remain in the lot after that date.

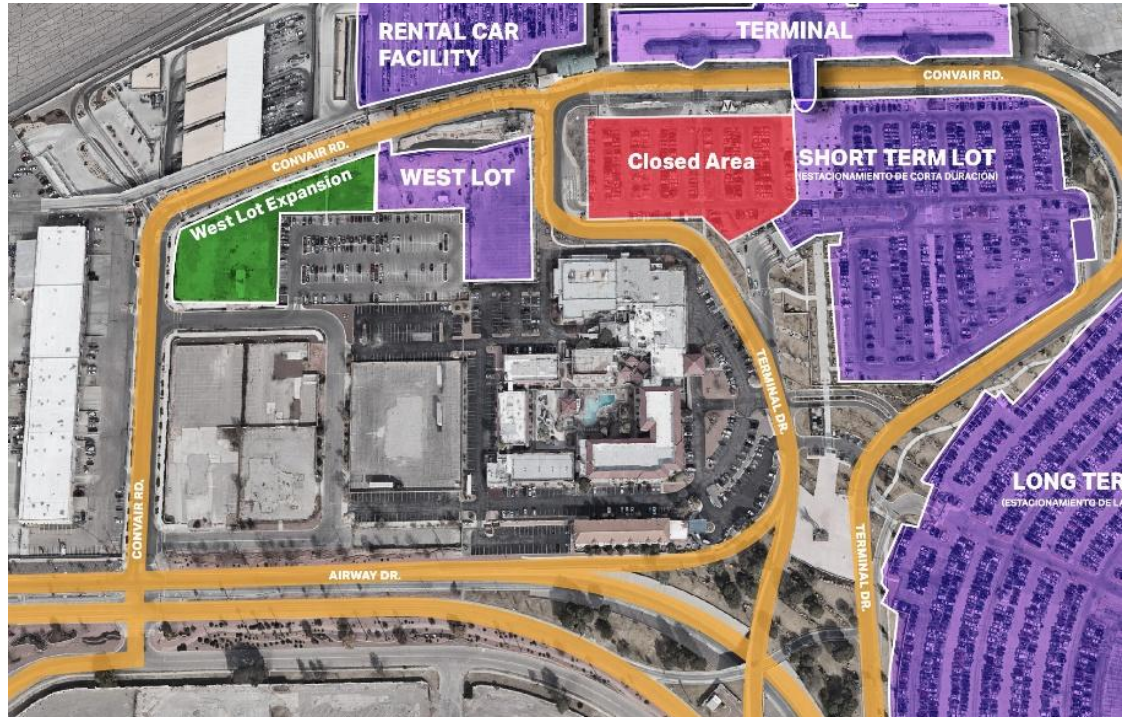
