City of El Paso Holiday Schedule, Tips for Household Trash, Recycling Services

EL PASO, Texas—The City of El Paso Environmental Services Department (ESD) is modifying its operating hours for the Christmas and New Year's holidays.

TRASH AND RECYCLING COLLECTIONS

To allow Environmental Services employees time to enjoy the holidays with their families, **gray and blue bins will not be collected on Thursday and Friday, December 25-26 and January 1-2.**

Holiday collection schedule:

- **Make-up day for Christmas:** Saturday, December 27. Gray bin only.
- **Make-up day for New Year's:** Saturday, Jan. 3. Gray bin only.
 - Blue bins will not be collected on the make-up days, and should be held until the next scheduled collection day for recyclables.

LANDFILL, CITIZEN COLLECTION STATIONS HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

The Greater El Paso Landfill and Citizen Collection Stations (CCS) will close December 25-26 and January 1-2, and will reopen at 7 a.m. on Saturday, January 3.

- Greater El Paso Landfill: 2600 Darrington
- Central: 2492 Harrison
- Eastside: 3510 Confederate
- Mission Valley: 1034 Pendale
- Northeast: 4501 Hondo Pass
- Westside: 121 Atlantic

FREE RECYCLING OF LIVE HOLIDAY TREES

- Recycle live holiday trees for free starting December 27 at any Citizen Collection Station.
- Trees must be free of ornaments and other decorative items including string lights, frost and glitter.
- A water bill is not required to drop off live holiday trees or recyclable materials.

FREE TURKEY GREASE RECYCLING

- Residents may dispose of turkey grease and cooking oil at a Citizen Collection Station for free.
- Water bill is not required to drop off grease or oil.
