## City of El Paso Announces Delayed Start for Administrative Offices on Monday, January 26

**EL PASO, Texas**—To align with delayed school openings across the region, the City of El Paso will implement a delayed start for administrative offices on Monday, January 26, 2026.

Non-essential City employees are asked to coordinate with their supervisor and report to work at 10 a.m. Employees who have questions or are unsure how this applies to their role should contact their supervisor directly for guidance.

While the City anticipates dry road conditions, the delayed start is intended to provide flexibility for employees managing morning schedules impacted by school delays.

Essential personnel should follow department-specific guidance and report as scheduled unless otherwise directed. City services critical to public safety and operations will continue as needed.
