Council Approves Two Years of Street Resurfacing Improvements

Work Targets Streets with Worst Pavement Conditions

EL PASO, Texas—El Paso City Council approved the awarding of two contracts that will allow the City to resurface streets across El Paso over the next two years.

The plan supports up to \$66 million in work focused on streets with the most worn pavement, improving ride quality and helping streets last longer.

The streets in the 2026-27 Street Resurfacing List were chosen mainly based on the condition of the pavement and other factors, such as pending utility work, traffic volume and estimated costs. The list includes streets such as Sean Haggerty, Rich Beem, Cotton, and Executive Center.

All the streets in the new list have a pavement condition rating of “poor” or “marginal.” Streets not included in the list have pavement condition ratings of “fair,” “good,” “very good,” “excellent” or are in such poor shape they require reconstruction to rehabilitate the street requiring removal of the asphalt road.

“For years now, El Paso has been utilizing data-driven management processes to objectively prioritize streets for resurfacing. Each street is assessed and provided with a Pavement Condition Index (PCI) that ranks pavement from zero to 100 with zero being the worst requiring demolition and reconstruction of the roadway,” said Randy Garcia, Streets and Maintenance Department Director.

The Street Department is wrapping up the 2024-25 Street Resurfacing Project list, which delivered approximately \$38.7 million in resurfacing improvements to residential streets and heavily-traveled roadways, such as Lee Treviño, Sunland Park and El Paso Drive.
