## El Paso Artist and Farmers Market Returns Downtown for 15th Anniversary Season

**EL PASO, Texas**—The City of El Paso is proud to announce the return of the El Paso Artist and Farmers Market, also known as The Market, to Downtown for its 15th anniversary season.

For the first time since 2023, The Market’s regular season will kick off in the heart of Downtown on Saturday, March 7, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Vendors will line Mills Street and Main Street around San Jacinto Plaza, creating a vibrant marketplace atmosphere. The Market will operate on select Saturdays through September during its regular season. Dates are posted online.

“Since 2011, The Market has played an important role in supporting local artists, artisans, and farmers while bringing people together,” said Artist & Farmers Market Coordinator Paulina Rosas. “As we return to our downtown roots, we’re excited to celebrate 15 seasons of creativity, culture, and community, and to continue expanding access to the arts.”

The Market offers a wide variety of original art and handmade goods, cottage food items, locally grown produce, and live entertainment from area performers.

In addition to its regular season, The Market will host artisan vendor marketplaces at select 2026 special events, including Third Thursday evenings and signature City festivals such as Chalk the Block, Día de los Muertos, and WinterFest.

Managed by the City of El Paso Museums and Cultural Affairs Department, The Market has earned national recognition, including being named Newsweek’s #1 Christmas Market in the United States last year.
