# El Paso International Airport Expands Service With New Nonstop to Nashville

## New Route to Improve Connectivity to Key Cities

**El Paso, Texas**—The City of El Paso is announcing a new nonstop route connecting El Paso International Airport (ELP) to Nashville International Airport (BNA).

Southwest Airlines will begin service on October 1, 2026, marking another step forward in expanding air service options for travelers in the region.

The nonstop flights will operate on Mondays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Sundays, providing flexible options for both business and leisure travel.

“El Paso is not the edge of the map. We are a city on the rise,” said Mayor Renard U. Johnson. “This nonstop flight to Nashville is another sign that the country is paying attention to El Paso’s growth, our culture, and our economic momentum, and it makes it easier for visitors, businesses, and families to connect directly with our city.”

We encourage our community to take these flights, support them, and help us continue building more options,” Airport Director Tony Nevarez said. “This is an important step in our strategic vision to expand nonstop connectivity for El Paso.”

In addition to the new Nashville service, El Paso International Airport is pleased to announce increased frequencies on other popular routes through Southwest:

- Austin (AUS): Increasing from three to four weekly flights on Monday, Thursday, and Friday
- Los Angeles (LAX): Increasing from two to three flights on Monday, Thursday, and Friday and from one to two weekly flights Tuesday and Wednesday
