# City to Host Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony for Fire Station No. 20 Renovations

## \$1.45 Million Project Funded Through Voter-Approved 2019 Public Safety Bond

The City of El Paso is hosting a ribbon-cutting ceremony for the completed renovations at Fire Station No. 20, located at 8301 Edgemere Avenue.

The \$1.45 million project is funded through the voter-approved 2019 Public Safety Bond, which supports improvements to public safety facilities across the city. Renovations include:

- Interior and exterior facility improvements
- New flooring, ceilings, windows, doors, and interior painting
- A new kitchen, restrooms, showers, and decontamination room
- Upgrades to HVAC, electrical, and plumbing systems
- Parking lot striping and asphalt sealing

These improvements help provide firefighters with safer, more functional facilities that support emergency response and day-to-day operations.

“The voter-approved 2019 Public Safety Bond is enhancing public safety in our community with the creation of new facilities that provide fire and police coverage to our growing city”, said El Paso Fire Chief Jonathan Killings. “Our emergency personnel, along with the renovations and upgrades to existing fire stations throughout the region are the backbone of what makes us one of the Nation’s safest cities”.

The investment reflects the City of El Paso’s continued commitment to maintaining and modernizing public safety infrastructure for residents and first responders.
