## El Paso Museum of History Invites Community to New Exhibition Featuring Austin Terrace Neighborhood

**EL PASO, Texas**—The El Paso Museum of History (EPMH) welcomes the public to explore its newest exhibition, *Neighborhoods and Shared Memories: Austin Terrace*, with a free opening event from 6:00pm to 8:00pm on Thursday, April 30.

The exhibition is the latest installment in a popular ongoing series that highlights El Paso's historic neighborhoods and the stories of the people who called them home.

Known as El Paso's first metropolitan suburb, Austin Terrace is a historically designated neighborhood in Central El Paso. Its diverse architectural styles, unique street layout, and lush greenery were influenced by notable architects like Mabel Welch, Henry C. Trost, and Otto H. Thorman. Construction of homes began in the 1920s and catered primarily to wealthy El Pasoans.

In addition to the homes in the neighborhood, institutions like Loretto Academy and the Radford School were influential forces in shaping the neighborhood's identity.

*Neighborhoods and Shared Memories: Austin Terrace* explores this history from the 1920s through 1970s while showcasing items borrowed from families and schools in the area.

The *Neighborhoods and Shared Memories: Austin Terrace* exhibition will run from April 30 to March 14, 2027.
