City to Host Grand Opening Ceremony for Newly Constructed Fire Station No. 38

\$5.4 Million Project Funded by 2019 Public Safety Bond

The City of El Paso will host a grand opening ceremony for Fire Station No. 38, a new facility funded through the voter-approved 2019 Public Safety Bond.

Located next to the Upper East Side Police Regional Command Center, the station strengthens emergency response in a rapidly growing area of the City.

The more than 9,000-square-foot facility includes:

- Three emergency vehicle bays with exhaust ventilation
- Dispatch office and IT server room
- Medical supply and equipment storage
- Decontamination and shower facilities
- Dormitory and industrial laundry facility
- Food preparation/service area, and a cold and dry food storage
- Fitness area
- Lobby and public restrooms

“Fire Station 38’s opening marks a significant milestone in our commitment to serve and protect our community,” said Fire Chief Jonathan Killings. “This state-of-the-art facility will enhance our response capabilities in far East El Paso and improve the overall safety for our community.”

The project, with an estimated budget of \$5.4 million for design and construction, reflects the City of El Paso’s continued commitment to upholding its status as one of the nation’s safest cities. An additional \$1.2 million in Public Safety Bond funds was allocated for the acquisition of emergency vehicles to support operations at the new station.
