Celebrate Cinco de Mayo at the MACC with Music, Food, and History

EL PASO, Texas—The El Paso Mexican American Cultural Center (MACC) invites the public to a free Cinco de Mayo celebration, presented by GECU Federal Credit Union, from 2 to 6 p.m. Saturday, May 9.

The second annual celebration will highlight the history, culture, and traditions of Puebla through live performances, hands-on activities, dance, chef demonstrations, and culinary experiences.

“For our second annual Cinco de Mayo celebration at the MACC, we invite our community to dive into the history of the celebration,” said Mexican American Cultural Center Director Rebecca Munoz. “Visitors will have the opportunity to learn about Poblano culture and the legacy of the Battle of Puebla through performances, hands-on activities, and chef demos.”

 - No registration required
- **Historia, Tradición, Alegría: La Batalla de Puebla performances by Ballet Folklórico Paso del Norte**
 - 3 p.m. and 4:45 p.m.
 - Advance registration required; free ticket required
- **Puebla Kitchen Stories on a Plate: Chef demos from Chef Regina Logar**
 - 2 p.m. and 4 p.m.
 - \$10 ticket required; 18 and older

The celebration also features **Sabores de Puebla**, a ticketed after-hours dinner experience on the MACC rooftop terrace. A paid ticket is required, with an optional VIP add-on that includes a special conversation with Chef Regina Logar.
