## City to Break Ground on \$1.29 Million Improvement Project at Pueblo Viejo Park

The City of El Paso invites the public to a groundbreaking ceremony for the Sun City Lights project at Pueblo Viejo Park, 233 N. Zaragoza Road.

This transformative project brings the Sun City Lights program to El Paso's Mission Valley, introducing decorative lighting features that enhance the park's nighttime visibility, enrich its visual character, and create a more welcoming, pedestrian-friendly environment for residents and visitors alike.

The \$1.29 million investment reflects a vision shaped through extensive community engagement and direct resident input. The resulting design is deeply rooted in the cultural heritage of the Mission Valley, ensuring that the project both honors and elevates the identity of the surrounding neighborhoods.

The project scope included:

- Pavilion with decorative lighting to include two concrete benches
- New sidewalks for connectivity with lighting
- Three concrete benches with illuminating pathway structures and interactive motion-sensor lighting
- New landscaping
- Irrigation improvements
- A rock wall monument sign
