## City to Host Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony for Fire Station No. 22 Renovations

The City of El Paso invites the public to a ribbon-cutting ceremony celebrating the completion of major renovations to Fire Station No. 22, at 6500 N. Mesa.

The approximately \$3.7 million renovation, funded through the voter-approved 2019 Public Safety Bond, strengthens the City's emergency response capabilities by modernizing the station and improving operational efficiency for El Paso Fire Department crews.

Improvements include:

- Interior and exterior renovations
- New flooring, lighting control panel, and upgraded fire alarm system
- New kitchen, restrooms, showers, and decontamination room
- HVAC, electrical, and plumbing upgrades
- New additions for locker rooms, an exercise area, EMS supply space, new bay doors, and landscaping

The Fire Station No. 22 renovation is part of the City of El Paso's continued investment in public safety infrastructure and its commitment to maintaining El Paso's standing as one of the nation's safest cities.
