Pedestrian Left with Serious Injuries After Collision

Date/Time: 7/27/2022 at 1:45 PM

Location: 400 Cabaret Drive

Vehicle: Ford F-150

Driver: Juan Lopez, 50 years old, Central El Paso, Texas resident

Pedestrian: Maria Del Carmen Carrales, 72 years old, Westside El Paso, Texas resident

El Paso, Texas – The El Paso Police Department’s Special Traffic Investigations Unit is investigating a vehicle versus pedestrian collision that occurred at the 400 block of Cabaret Drive. The preliminary investigation revealed the Ford F-150, driven by Juan Lopez, was entering Cabaret Drive from a private driveway when it struck the pedestrian, Maria Del Carmen Carrales, who was walking on the roadway. As a result of the collision, Carrales sustained serious injuries and was transported to University Medical Center for treatment. The contributing factors to this collision are Lopez failing to yield the right of way to the pedestrian and the pedestrian being on the roadway.

The investigation continues.
