City of El Paso Receives National League of Cities Economic Mobility Grant

El Paso, Texas— The City of El Paso is proud to announce its participation in the National League of Cities' (NLC) Advancing Economic Mobility Rapid Grant program.

This initiative, supported by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, will provide El Paso with a \$20,000 grant and six months of expert coaching from NLC to enhance local economic mobility.

"We are honored to participate in the Advancing Economic Mobility Rapid Grant program," said Mirella Tamayo, Economic Development Assistant Director. "This grant will significantly impact our community by empowering residents with the tools and knowledge to improve their financial stability.
