Three Officers Hit with Car Driven by Fleeing Wanted Subject

Date and time: January 12, 2021 at 8:10 pm

Location: Vista Del Sol and Pullman

Offender 1: 28 –year old Dejovan Scott James

Outstanding Criminal Warrants: three counts Possession of Controlled Substance,
two counts Delivery of Marijuana

Charges: three counts Aggravated Assault on a Public Servant, \$150,000 bond.
Evading Arrest with a Motor Vehicle, \$25,000 bond.

Offender 2: 28 –year old Malik A. Heath

Charges: Possession of a Controlled Substance and Possession of Marijuana \$2,000 bond.

EL PASO, Texas — A 28-year old male wanted on various drug charges struck three officers with his car while fleeing from the scene of a traffic stop.

An officer conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of Vista Del Sol and Pullman. The driver, 28- year old Dejovan Scott James had outstanding criminal warrants for various drug charges. Both James and his passenger, 28-year old Malik A. Heath were asked to step out of the vehicle. When two assisting officers arrived there, James ran into his vehicle and drove in reverse striking the three officers. Fortunately, only one officer required medical attention for injuries to her leg.

Heath was arrested at the scene for possession of methamphetamine and marijuana. Detectives located James at his place of employment at 10365 Railroad. Both were booked into the El Paso County Detention Facility.
