# Second Crash in Same Day and Location Leaves another Driver Critically Injured

**Driver: 46 –year old Ismael Alfredo Duron Pasillas of Socorro, Texas**

**Vehicle: 2004 Ford Explorer**

**Driver: 72 –year old Reyna Ley-Montes of Canutillo, Texas**

**Passenger: 7 –year old male**

EL PASO, Texas — Investigators with the Special Traffic Investigations Unit were called for the second time yesterday to I-10 West and Trans Mountain Rd. Investigators learned shortly after 3:30 PM, 72 –year old Reyna Ley-Montes was traveling on N. Desert Blvd when she swerved off the road, crossed the dirt median and entered the westbound lanes of the interstate. The 2004 Ford Explorer driven by Ley-Montes crashed into the right side of the 2005 Freightliner Conventional driven by 46 –year old Ismael Alfredo Duron Pasillas. This caused the tractor-trailer to veer left off the roadway and onto the center dirt median. The truck struck the cable barrier and jack-knifed, coming to a rest on the median. The impact caused the Explorer to leave the roadway and land in a concrete embankment off the highway. Ley-Montes suffered life-threatening head injuries and was transported to University Medical Center. Her 7 –year old male passenger sustained minor injuries and was also transported to UMC. Pasillas was not injured. The cause of the collision is still under investigation at this time.
