Driver Loses Control of Vehicle, Crashes and Causes Serious Injuries

Driver 1: Hispanic male, 25 years old, Northeast El Paso, Texas resident

Passenger: Hispanic female, 22 years old, New Mexico resident

Vehicle 1: 2005 Ford Mustang

Driver 2: Hispanic male, 38 years old, New Mexico resident

Passenger: Hispanic male, 23 years old, New Mexico resident

Vehicle 2: 2019 Ford F-350

El Paso, Texas – The El Paso Police Department’s Special Traffic Investigators are investigating a collision that occurred at the 5500 Block of Railroad. Preliminary investigation has revealed the Ford F-350, which was towing a trailer was parked on the right side emergency lane on the 5500 Block of Railroad. The male driving the 2005 Mustang, was driving northbound on Railroad and for unknown reasons, lost control of his vehicle and veered onto the emergency lane colliding with the F-350. As a result of the collision, the driver and the passenger of the Mustang suffered serious injuries, both were transported to University Medical Center for treatment. The driver is expected to recover and the passenger is listed to be in critical but stable condition. The driver and passenger in the F-350 did not report any injuries.
