# Shooting on McKelligon

Date and time: March 3, 2021

Location: 918 McKelligon

Victim: Two city Environmental Services Employees

Offender: 63 –year old Robert Hugh Moses

EL PASO, Texas — Officers were dispatched to 918 McKelligon on a shooting. The caller was the resident claiming he had shot at burglars. Officers arrived and saw two clearly marked City of El Paso utility trucks parked along the curb. Two Environmental Services employees clearing overgrown vegetation from the yard were the targets of the shooting from inside the residence. Officers contacted the resident and he surrendered himself and the rifle he used in the shooting.

The investigation revealed prior notice was given to the resident concerning his unkempt yard. Additionally, the two employees attempted to notify 63 –year old Robert Hugh Moses after they saw him on the sidewalk and enter his house but he would not answer knocks on his door. Their presence and purpose was evident. Pursuant to a court issued warrant, the employees/victims went about the task of clearing the yard, when Moses shot at them. While executing a search warrant inside the residence detectives discovered the decomposing carcass of a dog. Additional investigation is continuing in the case. Moses was booked into the El Paso County Detention Facility under a \$250,000 bond.
