## 6<sup>th</sup> Traffic Fatality of 2023

**Date/Time:** 01/14/23 @0430hrs.  
**Location:** Loop 375 West at Midway

**Vehicle 1:** Unknown dark-colored vehicle (fled scene)  
**Driver1:** Unknow

**Pedestrian:** John Doe (**Deceased**)

**El Paso, Texas** –The Special Traffic Investigators Unit (STI) was called to investigate a fatal hit-and-run collision involving a vehicle and a pedestrian. The preliminary investigation revealed that a group of pedestrians was crossing Loop 375 from south to north while vehicle 1 traveled westbound on the #1 lane. Vehicle 1 struck the pedestrian in the same lane before fleeing the scene. The pedestrian was transported to University Medical Center, where they tragically died. The presence of a pedestrian on the roadway is a factor in this collision—Investigators believe the vehicle involved in this incident to be dark-colored. STI urges anyone with information regarding the hit-and-run vehicle to contact them through the non-emergency number 915-832-4400 or to remain anonymous by calling Crime Stoppers at 915 566-8477. This incident marks the 6th traffic fatality this year, compared to two last year.
