Burglary of Habitation on Pikes Peak

EL PASO, Texas — Northeast patrol officers responded to the 5000 block of Pikes Peak on an aggravated assault in progress. When officers arrived, they located Robbinson outside the residence with a knife. Officers gave commands to drop the knife, which she quickly complied with. Officers then placed Robbinson under investigative detention while the officers determined what had occurred. The officer's investigation determined Robbinson had entered the residence without permission, and while in the home, she had an altercation with the victim, stabbing him in the upper torso. Officers also located a white dog with a laceration. The male victim was transported to a local hospital, where he was treated for non-life-threatening injuries. The injury to the dog was assigned to the Animal Cruelty Unit, which is continuing to investigate the case. Robbinson was taken before a magistrate, given a bond of 75,000, and booked into the El Paso County Detention Facility.
