## Child \& Woman Killed In Crash

El Paso, Texas - A crash in Northeast El Paso on Sunday morning kills a child and a woman. On Sunday, May 21, 2023, Officers of the El Paso Police Department and Fire Medical Personnel responded to a serious crash involving two vehicles at Dyer and Trans Mountain. The Special Traffic Investigations Unit responded to the scene to assist in the investigation.

The preliminary investigation suggests that Driver-2 was traveling north on Dyer and was approaching Trans Mountain. At the same time, Driver-1 was traveling south on Dyer, and made a left turn onto Trans Mountain. The collision resulted in six people injured, including both drivers and two people killed. At this time, the investigation continues, and no charges have been filed at this time. This fatal crash is the 24th and 25th traffic death of 2023, compared to 28 at the same time last year. Due to the ongoing investigation and notification to family names are not yet being released. Once the investigation permits, additional information will become available.
