Road Rage Escalates to Murder

El Paso, Texas— Detectives from the Crimes Against Persons Unit are investigating a fatal shooting that took place on Doniphan yesterday. According to the initial investigation, Raul Orozco and the victim, 32-year-old Marcos Fino Jr., were driving on Doniphan when an altercation occurred between them while they were in their respective vehicles. Raul began chasing the victim, who had three other individuals with him. During the pursuit, Raul called upon his sons, Jose, and Cristian Orozco, for help. When they reached the 5900 block of Doniphan, Jose, and Cristian positioned their vehicle in front of Fino's car, blocking him in. Raul Orozco then blocked Fino's car from behind with his truck. This led to a verbal confrontation that turned physical between the brothers, the victim, and his male passenger. During the fight, Jose shot the victim. The Orozco's then fled the scene and contacted the police from an address on the 300 block of Montoya. The victim's male passenger attempted to get Fino medical attention by driving away on Doniphan but stopped at the 6100 block of Doniphan, where he flagged down a police unit. This morning, Raul, Cristian, and Jose Orozco were arrested and taken to the El Paso County Detention Facility.
