## City's 32<sup>nd</sup> Fatal Is A Hit And Run

**History - El Paso, Texas**— Special Traffic Investigators continue investigating last night's pedestrian fatality. The investigators' preliminary information is that the 57-year-old male attempted to cross the 8200 block of Dyer at the crosswalk. The investigation revealed he did not have the signal to travel and began crossing Dyer's southbound lanes. The pedestrian continued walking, clearing the turning lane and the first lane of northbound Dyer; however, the pedestrian was hit in the second lane by a light-colored car knocking him into the third lane of Dyer. While on the ground, the white GMC ran over the pedestrian. Both vehicles fled the scene. The 57-year-old was transported to a local hospital but died from his injuries. Contributing factor in this crash is the pedestrian crossing against the control signal. This is the 32<sup>nd</sup> fatality this year as compared to 32 last year.
