EL PASO, Texas—El Paso Police Department Crimes Against Persons detectives are investigating a home invasion incident that occurred on July 14, 2024 at a residence on the 400 block of S. Mesa Hills. Officers responded in reference to a shooting. Upon arrival, officers found the victim with a gunshot wound to the abdomen. He was transported to an area hospital with non-life threatening injuries. Mosher was placed under arrest by the US Marshals Lone Star Task Force on August 9, 2024 for his involvement in the home invasion. He was booked into the El Paso County Detention Facility with a total bond of \$150,000.

Two juveniles were also identified for their involvement in the case. A 16-year-old male juvenile was taken into custody on August 27th and referred to the Juvenile Probation Department. A 15-year-old female juvenile was also involved and referred to JPD on September 5, 2024.
