Elderly Pedestrian Injured In Crash

El Paso, Texas – On Tuesday, January 23, 2024, Officers of the El Paso Police Department responded to a call of a serious crash involving a pedestrian. The pedestrian, an 85-year old male was seriously injured and was taken to a local hospital by Fire-Medical crews. Due the seriousness of the injuries, investigators from the Special Traffic Investigations Unit responded to the scene. Investigators found that the driver of the Nissan was traveling westbound on the 6500 block of Edgemere. As the vehicle entered the intersection of Sioux, the pedestrian was crossing Edgemere and entered into the path of the car. The driver was unable to avoid the collision and struck the pedestrian. The pedestrian was on the crosswalk, but is believed to have been crossing while not having the right of way and attempted to cross against the light.
