**EL PASO, Texas**— On April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025, Special Traffic Investigators located the vehicle that fled the scene. Through the investigation, police identified Rangel as the driver. On 04-21-2025, Investigators placed Evany under arrest. She was booked into the El Paso County Detention Facility with the above-listed bond.

## **History**

**El Paso, Texas** - The Special Traffic Investigations Unit responded to the 1700 block of Zaragoza to a collision involving a pedestrian in a wheelchair. The pedestrian was on Zaragoza and at the same time an unknown vehicle was traveling southbound at the 1700 block of Zaragoza when it struck Jesus Flores Garcia and fled the scene of the collision. Mr. Garcia was transported to the hospital and unfortunately succumbed to the injuries he sustained.
