# Memorial Day Weekend Operation

**Date:** 05-23 to 05-27-2025

**EL PASO, Texas**— A coordinated weekend with our law enforcement partners resulted in significant enforcement activity, including over 60 arrests and nearly 200 citations issued.

The operation focused on impaired driving, drug offenses, and outstanding warrants—the initiative aimed to enhance public safety and reduce impaired driving incidents ahead of the summer season. No traffic-related fatalities occurred during this time frame.

Key results of the operation were the following:

**Driving While Intoxicated (DWI) Arrests: 42**, which included the following breakdown.

- DWI: 30
- DWI with Open Alcohol Container: 1
- DWI with Child Under 15: 2
- DWI with Blood Alcohol Content  $\geq 0.15$ : 5
- Felony DWI (3rd offense or more): 1
- DUI-Minor: 3

**Drug-Related Arrests: 9**

- Possession of Controlled Substance: 6
- Possession of Marijuana: 3

**Felony Warrant Arrests: 11**

**Justice of the Peace (JP) Warrants: 8**

**Class C Arrests: 3**

- Minor in Possession of Tobacco: 2
- Minor Consuming Alcohol: 1

**-Other Arrests: 1**

- Criminal Mischief: 1

**Total Citations Issued: 191**
