# Gang Unit Assists in Arrest Following Aggravated Assault Shooting

**Location:** 3700 Hueco Valley

**Victim:** 19-year-old male resident of El Paso, TX

**Arrested:** 19-year-old Jair Armando Rodriguez, resident of East El Paso, TX

**Charge:** Aggravated Assault w/ Deadly Weapon

**Judge:** Aun

**Bond:** \$20,000

**EL PASO, Texas**— On December 28, 2025, the El Paso Police Department Gang Unit assisted officers with a shooting investigation involving a road-rage related incident.

Officers determined the incident involved a confrontation between motorists that escalated while the vehicles were in motion. Preliminary information indicates the victim was traveling in the area when a suspect, later identified as Jair Armando Rodriguez, engaged in aggressive driving behavior. The incident escalated, resulting in a collision and Rodriguez shooting at the victim.

The victim was able to flee, and no serious injuries were reported.

Following the incident, Rodriguez fled the area and was later involved in a separate traffic collision. The suspect vehicle was subsequently located abandoned. Later that day, through coordinated efforts, officers identified the suspect and Rodriguez was located and taken into custody without incident. An arrest warrant was obtained for Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and the individual was booked into the El Paso County Detention Facility.

This remains an active case, and no further details are available at this time.
