TXDOT STEP Grant Funds Increased Traffic Enforcement

El Paso, Texas – The El Paso Police Department will have increased traffic enforcement from **March 13th through March 22nd**. The increased enforcement is made possible through a grant provided by the Texas Department of Transportation as part of the **Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP)**.

During this period, officers will focus on reducing dangerous driving behaviors, including:

- **Driving While Intoxicated (DWI)**
- **Speeding**
- **Distracted driving**
- **Safety belt violations**
- **Controlled intersection violations**
