Suspect Flees Traffic Stop, Nearly Strikes Officer

Offender: Jacob Wayne Williams, 31-year-old, El Paso TX Resident
Offense: Agg Assault Against Public Servant
Bond: \$50,000
Offense: Evading Arrest or Detention with Vehicle
Bond: \$15,000

El Paso TX - On April 17th, 2026, officers with the El Paso Police Department attempted a traffic stop at the 300 block of W. San Antonio Avenue. When the officer made contact with the driver, he turned the vehicle toward the officer who was on a bicycle. The driver, Jacob Wayne Williams, accelerated nearly striking the officer.

The offender fled, driving onto a sidewalk and continuing northbound on Durango before running a stop sign and fleeing westbound on Franklin Avenue. The vehicle was later found unoccupied near a residence in the Sunset Heights area. The listed warrants were obtained for Jacob Wayne Williams. He was taken into custody by the Lone Star Fugitive Task Force and later booked into the El Paso County Detention Facility.
