STI Responds to Loop 375

EL PASO, Texas – On 07/21/2026 STI was requested to Loop 375 South at MM 44 to a collision involving 3 vehicles. The preliminary investigation revealed the Tundra was traveling South on Loop 375 at a high rate of speed, and passing vehicles. The Genesis and Nissan were traveling South on Loop 375 when the Tundra cut across all lanes of traffic and side swiped the Genesis. The Tundra continued and rear ended the Nissan. As a result of the rear-end collision, the Tundra spun and collided with the center barrier and ultimately collided with a concrete pole. Isaac Ibarra and Fabian Alonzo both succumbed to injuries sustained in the collision. Speed and unsafe lane change are contributing factors in the collision.

These are the 29th and 30th traffic fatalities of 2026 compared to 34 last year. The investigation continues...
