# City Soon to Begin Improvements to Edgemere Linear Park

**WHO:** City of El Paso Capital Improvement Department

**WHAT:** Open House Preconstruction Community Meeting

**WHERE:** **Library of Burges High School, 7800 Edgemere Boulevard**

**WHY:** The City of El Paso's Capital Improvement Department, in conjunction with the Office of City Representative Cassandra Hernandez of District 3, have scheduled an open house preconstruction community meeting in order to present to the public the construction schedule for the Edgemere Linear Park Improvements project.

The proposed project supports the improvements to the trail and two medians of the existing Edgemere Linear Park located between **Airway Boulevard** and **Hawkins Boulevard** near Burges High School. The project consists of the re-construction of the existing trail, and the installation of new vegetation, lighting, drainage improvements, landscaping modifications, improvements to sidewalks, curb-gutter and ADA compliant ramps.

This project is part of the City of El Paso's commitment to improve El Paso's regional comprehensive transportation system.
