In conjunction with the office of City Representative Sam Morgan of District 4, the City of El Paso's Museums and Cultural Affairs Department and the Capital Improvement Department have scheduled a community meeting to discuss the public art component for the Joey Barraza and Vino Memorial Park (Northeast Regional Park).

The meeting will be Wednesday, November 28, at 6 p.m. at Veteran's Recreation Center, 5301 Salem Drive.

Tim Watkins and Carol May, May + Watkins Design, will present previous installations and listen to community input that will be used to develop the art piece that will be incorporated into the regional park. May and Watkins build unique, interactive and educational exhibits for children. Their work has been incorporated into play spaces and public art projects in Maine, Tennessee and Colorado.

Located adjacent to US Highway 54 and McCombs, the Joey Barraza and Vino Memorial Park currently serves the community of Northeast El Paso. It currently contains four baseball or softball fields and three large soccer fields. The last time additions were made to the park was in 2014 when the city built a skate park. Phase two of the project has a budget of \$3.5 million and is funded by the voter-approved 2012 quality of life bond. The plans for the project include parking for food trucks, a plaza, four flat fields including a championship field, a dog park and walking trails.
