Temporary Closure of Sioux Street

EL PASO, Texas – The City of El Paso’s Capital Improvement Department has scheduled a temporary closure of Sioux Street at the intersection of Edgemere Boulevard beginning the week of June 18, 2018.

The closure is part of the Edgemere Parkway Improvements project, and is necessary to allow construction crews to complete their work efficiently and safely.

The proposed project is funded by a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and supports the development of a pedestrian and bicycle corridor along Edgemere Boulevard just to the east of Geronimo Drive and to the west of Robert E. Lee Road. The approximate \$1 million project consists of the construction of a 10-foot pedestrian and bicycle path with trees, vegetation, new lighting, and ADA compliant ramps.

The closure is scheduled to last one month, and appropriate signage and detours will be in place throughout the duration of the closure. Residents are encouraged to seek alternate routes throughout the closure, and the construction schedule, detours and closures may be modified in order to accommodate any unforeseen conditions or events.

The project is part of the City of El Paso’s commitment to improve El Paso’s regional comprehensive transportation system.
