Recycling Tips

- Make sure to rinse off any food or product residue
- Flatten cardboard boxes and bag your bags to save some space
- Don't put your bin out if it's not at least ½ full
- Don't put your bin out if winds are gusting above 40mph or if it's below 20° outside

ESD Garbage Collection

ESD picks up your garbage once a week, along with recyclables. Trash goes in your gray bin, recyclables in the blue. Pretty simple, right?



A few things to remember...

Put your bins out after 6pm the night before your pickup day, and get them off the street by 7pm on collection day.

Keep **ALL** bins at least **3 ft. apart** from one another and from mailboxes, utility poles or walls/fences. Keep them **5 ft. away** from vehicles.

Make sure your garbage bin isn't overflowing (lid closed) and lid hinges are toward the home, otherwise, your bin will not be serviced. And please, no chemicals, dead animals, computers, rocks, construction or yard waste.

For your safety, stay away at least 30 ft. from the collection truck or your bin will not be serviced. Don't refill your bins or cross the street for a second collection.

For bin repairs or replacements, call 3-1-1. **ESD offers discounts to seniors and the disabled.**

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

The City of El Paso recognizes the following holidays:

If a holiday falls on your pickup day, don't worry. We'll get your bins on the Saturday that follows the holiday.

ESD Landfill



Dispose of extra waste at the Greater El Paso Landfill at 2300 Darrington Road. Open Mon-Sat, 7am-4pm.

ESD's landfill rate is \$26/ton with a minimum fee of \$16. The Landfill may close or change hours when it's windy, rainy, or snowy. Call 3-1-1 to check hours.

ESD Dead Animal Removal

Dead animals must be bagged and placed at the edge of your curb prior to pickup. Fees range from \$20 to \$175 and will be added to your water bill. There is no fee to remove dead animals from City roadways. Call 311 from 7am-4pm.

ESD Special Collections

ESD picks up extra items from your home for a fee. Service is available Mon-Fri from 8am-3pm, just call 311.

ESD Citizen Collection Stations
