EL PASO, TEXAS: Investigators assigned to the Special Traffic Investigations (STI) are asking for the community's assistance in the identification of the vehicle in the listed photographs. Investigators believe that this is the Hit and Run vehicle that struck and killed a 68-year old Male Pedestrian Saturday evening. If you know where this vehicle is, or who owns it, you are asked to call the El Paso Police Department at 915.832.4400 or to remain anonymous call Crime Stoppers of El Paso at 915.566.8477.

History 06/19/2017

El Paso, TX. -The El Paso Police Department's Special Traffic Investigation (STI) unit has been notified that the pedestrian that was struck Saturday evening has passed away. Investigators were notified that he passed away on Sunday. The pedestrian's identity is pending notification of next of kin. This pedestrian becomes the 24th traffic fatality of 2017 compared to 33 during this same time period last year. History 06/18/2017

El Paso, TX. -The El Paso Police Department's Special Traffic Investigation (STI) unit responded to assist Central Patrol officers with a non-fatal traffic collision that involved a vehicle and pedestrian. The preliminary investigation revealed that the driver of a black sports car (possibly Honda Civic, 2 doors, with possible front end damage) was north on Cleveland at a high rate of speed and ran the stop sign at the intersection with Clark. At the same time a pedestrian was crossing southbound on Clark St., and was struck by the vehicle. The vehicle fled the scene. The pedestrian suffered life threatening injuries and was transported to University Medical Center for treatment. STI is asking anyone with any information regarding this collision to contact STI at 915.212.4000 or to remain anonymous call Crime Stoppers of El Paso at 915.566.8477. This investigation continues.
