Update Driver Uninjured After Bullets Strike His Car

Date and Time: April 15, approximately 4:40 p.m.
Location: 4651 Cohen
Offender: 22 –Year old Deyone Quartaril Bridges

EL PASO, TEXAS- SWAT and CMT officers converged on an apartment yesterday to execute high risk search and arrests warrants. Following up on the investigation into the shooting early Saturday morning on Kenworthy, Gang investigators procured warrants of arrests and search of the residence located at 4651 Cohen. The warrants were successfully executed without incident. 22 –year old Deyone Quartaril Bridges was booked into the El Paso County Detention Facility charged with Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon and a previous warrant for Burglary of Habitation under bonds totaling over \$155,000. The mugshot will not be available as the case is still under investigation.
